

# Fund Descriptions

**Dunaier Music Fund** - funds are used to maintain and enhance our musical programming as well as our existing sound systems and equipment.

**Early Childhood Education Fund** - funds are used to augment the Early Childhood Education program with additional enrichment programs and materials.

**Fienberg-Lerner Chapel Minyan Fund** – funds are used to support the Chapel Minyan and other Shabbat services.

**Hazzan Duek's Discretionary Fund** - charitable fund used for individual, educational and communal needs.

**Inbar Israel Scholarship and Education Fund** - funds are used to provide scholarship money to children of TEC members for travel to Israel with organized Jewish youth groups or for study in Israel.

**Jotkowitz Camp Ramah Fund** - fund are used to award scholarships for children to attend Camp Ramah.

**Ner Tamid Education & Community Center Fund** – funds are used to maintain and enhance the new buildings; as are contributions to the following three funds:

*Jack Kirby Memorial Fund*

**Rabbi Spiegel's Discretionary Fund** - charitable fund used for individual, educational and communal needs.

**Religious School Fund** - funds are used to augment the Religious School with additional enrichment programs and materials.

**Religious School Scholarship Funds (RSSF)-**

These two funds provide provide scholarships for Religious School tuition.

**Ritual Fund** - funds are used to purchase ritual objects and prayer books used in the performance of regular, minyan and holiday services.

**Tzedakah Fund** - funds are sent to charitable agencies in Israel.

**USY Youth & Scholarship Fund** - funds are used to augment the USY program with additional enrichment programs and materials as well as provide scholarships to offset the cost of sending students to Regional Convention and Kinnusim.

**Zerlin Library Fund** - funds are used to purchase books for the Cohen Family Library; as are contributions to the *Barry Cantor Memorial Fund*.

## MEN'S CLUB FUNDS

**Scholar-in-Residence** - Provides financial support for the Men's Club's annual Scholar-in-Residence program, which brings renowned scholars to TEC for a weekend of congregational study and learning on contemporary Jewish issues.

**Silverstein Humanitarian** - Provides funding for Men's Club social action activities in support of worthwhile humanitarian causes.

## SISTERHOOD FUND

**Torah Fund** - Enables rabbinic and cantorial students, educators and community leaders to receive a superior education at the Jewish Theological Seminary in New York, the Schechter Institute in Jerusalem and at our own Ziegler School of Rabbinic Studies at the University Of Judaism in Los Angeles.

**NO PREFERENCE (Temple General Fund)** - Funds are used at Board discretion.
