

## High Holiday Information 2009/ 5770



Dear Congregants and Friends,

As the **High Holidays** approach, it is time to make arrangements for High Holiday tickets and reserved seating. All services will be held in the Paskow Sanctuary. Please be aware that everyone must have a ticket. Tickets will continue to be checked by outside security guards. Our goal is for all our members and guests to have a meaningful and comfortable High Holiday celebration.

- Admission tickets are included with your membership. (Please note that all unpaid fee balances from the prior year **must** be paid in full before High Holiday tickets will be issued.) The number of tickets you will receive is based upon your membership category.
- Members may choose to purchase a reserved pew or chair in the Paskow Sanctuary as listed below.
- Relatives of members and non-members must purchase a High Holiday ticket.
- In addition to the cost of the admission ticket, relatives of members may choose to upgrade to a reserved seat for the additional fee listed below.

Please remember when ordering your seats, that no child under the age of 8 will be admitted to the services except on the second day of Rosh Hashana. Child Care, High Holiday Experience and Family Services will be available, as options, on the other days of worship. Family members over 18 years of age, unless they are full-time students, will be expected to pay for their tickets.

The following is a review of related costs for the **2009 High Holiday Services**; Reserved seating requests must be received in the Temple office no later than September 1, 2009.
