Rabbi Nadav Caine came to the rabbinate from scholarship in religion and philosophy (B.A. Princeton, M.T.S. Harvard, A.B.D. Stanford) and leadership in Jewish education. While writing his dissertation and working widely in Jewish education, he decided he could do more for the Jewish community as a rabbi than as an academic. In 2005, he left his doctoral program to enter the rabbinate enrolling at the Ziegler School of Rabbinic Studies where he was ordained in 2011. Rabbi Caine became Spiritual Leader (a half time position) at Ner Tamid Synagogue in Poway (a suburb of San Diego) while in rabbinical school; and has served as its full time rabbi since 2011.

Rabbi Caine is known for his innovative programming and engaging teaching. He is an avid electric-car enthusiast, and roasts and brews his own coffee.

He takes no credit for the irresistible charm of his two young daughters, Merav, 7, and Ziva, 5, who take after their mother Lynne.
